#### LIBRARY SCIENCE COURSES

\* Candidates who have completed LIB 501 and/or LIB 569 with a grade of "C" or better may use those credit hours to reduce the number of hours required in the Library Science block by 3-6 hours. Candidates who have completed LIB 501 for credit may not take LIB 701. Candidates who have completed LIB 569 for credit may not take LIB 801.

#### NOTE
